[English, sinister, threatening, frightening, inhospitable, unwelcoming, unfriendly, hostile, dark, grim, Opposite of, hospitable]

- Christ was falsely accused of forbidding the paying of taxes.
- Then they started to accuse him, saying; This man we found subverting our nation and forbidding the paying of taxes to Caesar and saying he himself is Christ a king. (Luke 23:2)
- Paul spoke of false Christians who would arise in later times who would forbid marriage to their members. This had a fulfillment in the Catholic Church and it celibate Priests and Nuns. Paul showed that it is a teaching of the demons.
- However, the inspired utterance says definitely that in later periods of time some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to misleading inspired utterances and teachings of demons. (1 Timothy 4:1)
- Forbidding to marry, commanding to abstain from foods which God created to be partaken of with thanksgiving by those who have faith and accurately know the truth. (1 Timothy 4:3)
