~FOREMOST (100)

[English, leading, primary, prime, chief, principal]

- Jacob placed his maidservants and their children foremost when going out to meet with Esau.
- And he put the maidservants and their children foremost and Leah and her children after them and Rachel and Joseph to the rear of them. (Genesis 33:2)
- Babylon took Jehoiachin into exile along with the foremost people of the land.
- Thus he took Jehoiachin into exile to Babylon, and the king's mother and the kings wives and his court officials and the foremost men of the land he led away as exiled people from Jerusalem to Babylon. (2 Kings 24:15)
- In Ezra's day the deputy rulers and princes of the people were the foremost ones at leading the people to take foreign wives for themselves against Yehowah God's Law.
- For they have accepted some of their daughters for themselves and for their sons, and they, the holy seed, have become mingled with the peoples of the lands, and the hand of the princes and the deputy rulers has proved to be foremost in this unfaithfulness. (Ezra 9:2)
- The congregator said to listen to his for the foremost things were what he was speaking, important things.
- Listen, for it is about the foremost things that I speak, and the opening of my lips is about uprightness. (Proverbs 8:6)
- Nebuchadnezzar took away the foremost people of the land in the first Babylonian exile.
- Furthermore, he took one of the royal seed and concluded a covenant with him and brought him into an oath, and the foremost men of the land he took away. (Ezekiel 17:13)

- When Satan the Devil goes down to Sheol, then the foremost of the mighty men of the nations will speak out to him from there, all the uncircumcised ones of the earth who rule through oppression.
- The foremost men of the mighty ones will speak out of the midst of Sheol even to him, with his helpers. They will certainly go down, they must lie down as the uncircumcised, slain by the sword. (Ezekiel 32:21)
- Michael is spoken of as being one of the foremost princes of Yehowah God in heaven.
- But the prince of the royal realm of Persia was standing in opposition to me for twenty-one days, and, look! Michael, one of the foremost princes, came to help me, and I, for my part, remained there beside the kings of Persia. (Daniel 10:13)
- Herod spread a feast for his foremost friends, and the military commanders of Galilee.
- But a convenient day came along when Herod spread an evening meal on his birthday for his top-ranking men and the military commanders and the foremost ones of Galilee. (Mark 6:21)
- Judas hanged himself, and then burst foremost as his intestines were poured out in death.
- This very man, therefore, purchased a field with the wages for unrighteousness, and pitching head foremost he noisily burst in his midst and all his intestines were poured out. (Acts of Apostles 1:18)
- Paul considered himself to be among the foremost sinners among all men who gained salvation from Yehowah God through his Christ.
- Faithful and deserving of full acceptance is the saying that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. Of these I am foremost. (1 Timothy 1:15)
- Paul was shown this mercy for he was the foremost case of the extent that Yehowah God would go to, to show mankind his mercy.
- Nevertheless, the reason why I was shown mercy was that by means of me as the foremost case Christ Jesus might

demonstrate all his long-suffering for a sample of those who are going to rest their faith on him for everlasting life. (1 Timothy 1:16)
