[English, pardoned, excused, forgave and forgot, let off, absolved, exonerated, Opposite of, **blamed**]

- Jesus showed that the one the master freely **forgave** the most would have a greater love.
- When they did not have anything with which to pay back, he freely **forgave** them both. Therefore, which of them will love him the more? (**Luke 7:42**)
- In answer Simon said; I suppose it is the one to whom he freely **forgave** the more. He said to him; You judged correctly. (**Luke 7:43**)
- Christians should freely **forgive** one another just as Christ freely **forgave** them.
- But become kind to one another, tenderly compassionate, freely forgiving one another just as God also by Christ freely **forgave** you. (**Ephesians 4:32**)
- Furthermore, though you were dead in your trespasses and in the uncircumcised state of your flesh, God made you alive together with him. He kindly **forgave** us all our trespasses (**Colossians 2:13**)
- Continue putting up with one another and forgiving one another freely if anyone has a cause for complaint against another. Even as Yehowah freely **forgave** you, so do you also. (**Colossians 3:13**)
