

~FORGETFUL (26)

[English, absentminded, inclined to forget, neglectful, scabby, scatterbrained, dreamy]

- The Israelite nation became **forgetful** of Yehowah and his ways and mighty saving acts in their behalf.
- So the sons of Israel did what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, and they were **forgetful** of Yehowah their God and went serving the Baals and the sacred poles. (**Judges 3:7**)
- The Psalmist expressed his love of Yehowah saying he could not **forget** Jerusalem, the place of true worship.
- If I should forget you, O Jerusalem, let my right hand be **forgetful**. (**Psalms 137:5**)
- Paul showed that if the qualities expressed in verses 5-8 were not present in a Christian it would be because he had become **forgetful** of his cleansing of his sins of long ago.
- For if these things are not present in anyone, he is blind, shutting his eyes to the light, and has become **forgetful** of his cleansing from his sins of long ago. (**2 Peter 1:9**)
