- The Israelites quickly forgot God and did not wait for his good counsel.
- Quickly they forgot his works, they did not wait for his counsel.
 (Psalms 106:13)
- They forgot God their Savior, the Doer of great things in Egypt. (Psalms 106:21)
- They quickly followed after the Baals and other idol gods forgetting their God Yehowah.
- They are thinking of making my people forget my name by means of their dreams that they keep relating each one to the other, just as their fathers forgot my name by means of Baal. (Jeremiah 23:27)
- The Israelites forgot God because of their wealth and prosperity from the fine land he gave to them.
- According to their pasturage they also came to be satisfied. They became satisfied and their heart began to be exalted. That is why they forgot me. (Hosea 13:6)
