- The Israelites quickly **forgot** God and did not wait for his good counsel.
- Quickly they **forgot** his works, they did not wait for his counsel. (**Psalms 106:13**)
- They **forgot** God their Savior, the Doer of great things in Egypt. (**Psalms 106:21**)
- They quickly followed after the Baals and other idol gods **forgetting** their God Yehowah.
- They are thinking of making my people forget my name by means of their dreams that they keep relating each one to the other, just as their fathers **forgot** my name by means of Baal. (**Jeremiah 23:27**)
- The Israelites **forgot** God because of their wealth and prosperity from the fine land he gave to them.
- According to their pasturage they also came to be satisfied. They became satisfied and their heart began to be exalted. That is why they **forgot** me. (**Hosea 13:6**)
