[English, abandoned, deserted, left, disowned]

- Jeshurun, another name for Israel, forsook their god when they became fat and satisfied.
- When Jeshurun began to grow fat, then he kicked. You have grown fat, you have become thick, you have become gorged. So he forsook God, who made him, and despised the Rock of his salvation. (Deuteronomy 32:15)
- Yehowah eventually forsook the tabernacle at Shiloh when his people turned away from doing his will.
- And he finally forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent in which he resided among earthling men. (Psalms 78:60)
- The demon angels that sinned forsook their proper place in God's arrangement and have come under an adverse judgment from Yehowah.
- And the angels that did not keep their original position but forsook their own proper dwelling place he has reserved with eternal bonds under dense darkness for the judgment of the great day. (Jude 1:6)
