

~FRIGHTEN (48)

[English, scare, terrify, alarm, startle, upset, worry, panic, Opposite of, soothe]

- Daniel saw a night vision that had images that **frightened** him.
- There was a dream that I beheld, and it began to make me afraid. And there were mental images upon my bed and visions of my head that began to **frighten** me. (**Daniel 4:5**)
- As for me, Daniel, my spirit was distressed within on account of it, and the very visions of my head began to **frighten** me. (**Daniel 7:15**)
- Upon Yehowah showing Daniel what the king's dream meant Daniel begged that the dream applied to someone else rather than the king. The King of Babylon therefore comforted Daniel to not let it **frighten** him.
- At that time Daniel himself, whose name is Belteshazzar, was astonished for a moment, and his very thoughts began to **frighten** him. The king was answering and saying; O Belteshazzar, do not let the dream and the interpretation themselves frighten you. Belteshazzar was answering and saying; O my lord, may the dream apply to those hating you, and its interpretation to your adversaries. (**Daniel 4:19**)
- Later in another dream to a later King of Babylon a hand was seen writing upon his castle wall and his own thoughts began to **frighten** him so that his knees were knocking.
- At that time, as regards the king, his very complexion was changed in him, and his own thoughts began to **frighten** him, and his hip joints were loosening and his very knees were knocking each other. (**Daniel 5:6**)
- The Queen mother then also tried to comfort the King of Babylon saying; Do not let your thoughts **frighten** you.
- As regards the queen, because of the words of the king and his grandees she entered right into the banqueting hall. The queen answered and said; O king, keep living even to times indefinite.

Do not let your thoughts frighten you, nor let your complexion be changed. (Daniel 5:10)
