[English, unproductive, futile, ineffective, useless, unsuccessful, unrewarding, wasted, Opposite of, **fruitful**]

- Yehowah promised that if his people were obedient that he would rebuke the devouring one, and they would not prove to be **fruitless**.
- And I will rebuke for you the devouring one, and it will not ruin for you the fruit of the ground, nor will the vine in the field prove **fruitless** for you, Yehowah of armies has said. (**Malachi 3:11**)
- Paul described Christians' prior case of conduct as **fruitless**, meaning that they at that time lacked any good or positive spiritual fruitage.
- For you know that it was not with corruptible things, with silver or gold, that you were delivered from your **fruitless** form of conduct received by tradition from your forefathers. (**1 Peter 1:18**)
- Jude warned about shepherds who feed themselves without fear who are like trees in late autumn, **fruitless**.
- These are the rocks hidden below water in your love feasts while they feast with you, shepherds that feed themselves without fear, waterless clouds carried this way and that by winds, trees in late autumn, but **fruitless**, having died twice, having been uprooted. (**Jude 1:12**)
