[English, aggravate, irritate, upset, disturb, annoy, bother, discourage, Opposite of, encourage]

- David called upon his friend to frustrate the counsel of his rebellious son Absalom.
- But if you return to the city and you actually say to Absalom, I am your servant, O King. I used to prove myself the servant of your father, even I at that time, but now even I am your servant, you must then frustrate the counsel of Ahithophel for me. (2 Samuel 15:34)
- Then Absalom and all the men of Israel said; The counsel of Hushai the Archite is better than the counsel of Ahithophel! And Yehowah himself had given command to frustrate the counsel of Ahithophel although good, in order, that Yehowah might bring calamity upon Absalom. (2 Samuel 17:14)
- During Ezra's day the people of the land were frustrating the hands of the Jews so as not to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem and its temple.
- And hiring counselors against them to frustrate their counsel all the days of Cyrus the king of Persia down till the reign of Darius the king of Persia. (Ezra 4:5)
