~GADDI (20)

(Gad'di) [possibly from a root meaning good fortune]

- Son of Susi of the tribe of Manasseh, one of the 12 chieftains Moses sent out from the wilderness of Paran to spy out the land of Canaan.
- Send out for yourself men that they may spy out the land of Canaan, which I am giving to the sons of Israel. You will send out one man for each tribe of his fathers, each one a chieftain among them. (Numbers 13:2)
- So Moses sent them out from the wilderness of Paran at the order of Yehowah. All the men were heads of the sons of Israel. (Numbers 13:3)
- Of the tribe of Joseph, for the tribe of Manasseh, Gaddi the son of Susi. (Numbers 13:11)
