~GAIUS 3 (18)

(Ga'ius) [from a root meaning land]

- A Christian of Corinth whom Paul personally baptized. When Paul wrote his letter to the Romans, apparently this Gaius was his host as well as that of the congregation.
- This would indicate that the meetings of the Corinthian congregation were held in Gaius home.
- I am thankful I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius. (1 Corinthians 1:14)
- Gaius, my host and that of all the congregation, greets you. Erastus the city steward greets you, and so does Quartus his brother (Romans 16:23)
