- A Christian to whom the apostle John wrote his third inspired letter and whom he commended for walking in the truth and, with reference to his hospitality, for his faithful work and his love.
- The older man to Gaius, the beloved, whom I truly love. (3 John 1:1)
- For I rejoiced very much when brothers came and bore witness to the truth you hold, just as you go on walking in the truth. (3 John 1:3)
- No greater cause for thankfulness do I have than these things, that I should be hearing that my children go on walking in the truth. (3 John 1:4)
- Beloved one, you are doing a faithful work in whatever you do for the brothers, and strangers at that. (3 John 1:5)
- Who have borne witness to your love before the congregation. These you will please send on their way in a manner worthy of God. (3 John 1:6)
