~GALLIM (28) (Gal'lim) [Heaps]

- The home of Palti, to whom Saul gave his daughter Michal as his wife after David was outlawed.
- As for Saul, he had given Michal his daughter, David's wife, to Palti the son of Laish, who was from Gallim. (1 Samuel 25:44)
- It is possibly the same as the Gallim whose inhabitants, centuries later, cried out in lamentation over the approaching Assyrian army under Sennacherib.
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, has said; Do not be afraid, O my people who are dwelling in Zion, because of the Assyrian, who with the rod used to strike you and who used to lift up his own staff against you in the way that Egypt did. (Isaiah 10:24)
- Let your voice out in shrill cries, O daughter of Gallim. Pay attention, O Laishah. O you afflicted one, Anathoth! (Isaiah 10:30)
- Some scholars place Gallim at Khirbet Kakul, Horvat Ka`kul, about 4.5 kilometers (3 miles) North-Northeast of the Temple Mount.
