~GAREB 1 (42) (Ga'reb) [Scabby]

- One of David's mighty men, an Ithrite of the tribe of Judah.
- These are the names of the mighty men that belonged to David. Josheb-basshebeth a Tahchemonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over eight hundred slain at one time. (2 Samuel 23:8)
- Ira the Ithrite, Gareb the Ithrite. (2 Samuel 23:38)
- And Tamar his daughter-in-law it was that bore to him Perez and Zerah. All the sons of Judah were five. (1 Chronicles 2:4)
- The sons of Perez were Hezron and Hamul. (1 Chronicles 2:5)
- As for Caleb the son of Hezron, he became father to sons by Azubah his wife and by Jerioth, and these were her sons, Jesher and Shobab and Ardon. (1 Chronicles 2:18)
- Eventually Azubah died. So Caleb took to himself Ephrath, who in time bore Hur to him. (1 Chronicles 2:19)
- These became the sons of Caleb. The sons of Hur the firstborn of Ephrathah; Shobal the father of Kiriath-jearim. (1 Chronicles 2:50)
- And the families of Kiriath-jearim were the Ithrites and the Puthites and the Shumathites and the Mishraites. It was from these that the Zorathites and the Eshtaolites came out. (1 Chronicles 2:53)
- As for the mighty men of the military forces, there were Asahel the brother of Joab, Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem. (1 Chronicles 11:26)
- Ira the Ithrite, Gareb the Ithrite. (1 Chronicles 11:40)
