## ~GATHERS (100)

[English, meets, gets together, collects, congregates, assembles, groups, draws together, gathers round]

- Job showed that mortal man would simply die off, if Yehowah God gathers together his spirit from mankind.
- If he sets his heart upon anyone, if that one's spirit and breath he gathers to himself. (Job 34:14)
- The Psalmist looked for the salvation of Israel, when Yehowah God according to his spoken word gathers back the captive ones of his people.
- O that out of Zion there were the salvation of Israel! When Yehowah gathers back the captive ones of his people, let Jacob be joyful, let Israel rejoice. (Psalms 14:7)
- O that out of Zion there were the grand salvation of Israel!
  When Yehowah gathers back the captive ones of his people, let
  Jacob be joyful, let Israel rejoice. (Psalms 53:6)
- Like the arrogant King of Assyria, in our day the United Nations will feel, that taking and gathering the resources of all religion, will be as simple as plucking eggs from a deserted nest. They will feel, that there will be no one there to stop them. They do not feel that there even is a true God, and so they will see religion as powerless before them. Since they are also bankrupt, they will desire religion's wealth, and will strip it of all of its resources. They will feel, that if they rid the world of religion, then all of its rich resources will be theirs.
- And just as if a nest, my hand will reach the resources of the peoples, and just as when one gathers eggs that have been left, I myself will gather up even all the earth, and there will certainly be no one fluttering his wings or opening his mouth or chirping. (Isaiah 10:14)
- If will be eye unto eye that they will see it when Yehowah God gathers back the sons of Zion.
- Listen! Your own watchmen have raised their voice. In unison they keep crying out joyfully, for it will be eye into eye that they

will see when Yehowah gathers back Zion. (Isaiah 52:8)

- The entire purpose of the coming of them into the land is for mere violence. The assembling of their faces is like a parching east wind, bringing ruin. They gather up their captives as numerous as the sands of the sea.
- In its entirety it comes for mere violence. The assembling of their faces is as the east wind, and it gathers up captives just like the sand. (Habakkuk 1:9)
- Habakkuk now alludes to Satan the Devil being like a fisherman who gathers up the sons of mankind, catching them with his fishhook and dragging them away in his dragnet. That is why he rejoices and is joyful.
- All these he has brought up with a mere fishhook. He drags them away in his dragnet, and he gathers them in his fishing net. That is why he rejoices and is joyful. (Habakkuk 1:15)
- Jesus now talks about Jerusalem as the center of true worship in all the earth, and refers to how in his pre-human existence he shepherded this nation of Israel in the manner, that a mother hen gathers her chicks close around her for protection and care. Yet as a people, they did not want this care, and rejected time and again, also the loving assistance of the prophets, and killed most of them.
- Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the killer of the prophets and stoner of those sent forth to her, how often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks together under her wings! But you people did not want it. (Matthew 23:37)
- Then Jesus made another illustration, showing what he was like in heaven before coming to the earth. He compared himself there to a mother hen who gathers her brood of chicks, keeping them close by shepherding them with her wings. Yet he called Jerusalem the killer of all the prophets, and the stoner of all those who had been sent forth to her.
- Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the killer of the prophets and stoner of those sent forth to her, how often I wanted to gather your children together in the manner that a hen gathers her brood of chicks under her wings, but you people did not want it! (Luke
