~GAZED (65)

[English, looked, stared, fixed your eyes on, watched, gawked]

- Whenever Moses left his tent the people rose and gazed upon him until he went back into his tent again.
- And it occurred that as soon as Moses went out to the tent, all the people would rise, and they stationed themselves each one at the entrance of his own tent, and they gazed after Moses until he went into the tent. (Exodus 33:8)
- Everyone who gazed upon the copper serpent that Moses made, was saved from the bite of the serpent.
- Moses at once made a serpent of copper and placed it upon the signal pole, and it did occur that if a serpent had bitten a man and he gazed at the copper serpent, he then kept alive. (Numbers 21:9)
- Job showed that mortal men have gazed upon the mighty works of the true God Yehowah from far off.
- All mankind themselves have gazed upon it, mortal man himself keeps looking from far off. (Job 36:25)
- Yehowah God has an established place in heaven from where he has gazed upon the sons of mankind.
- From the established place where he dwells he has gazed at all those dwelling on the earth. (Psalms 33:14)
- Peter and John gazed at the man, and then asked the man to take a look at them, for they were not well to do men, and it certainly showed.
- But Peter, together with John, gazed at him and said; Take a look at us. (Acts of Apostles 3:4)
- Yet as all those within the Sanhedrin chamber gazed at Stephen, they saw that his face was as an angel's face.
- And as all those sitting in the Sanhedrin gazed at him, they saw

that his face was as an angel's face. (Acts of Apostles 6:15)

- So Stephen, who was full of Holy Spirit gazed up to heaven and he caught sight of God's glory, and of Jesus Christ standing at his right hand of power.
- But he, being full of Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and caught sight of God's glory and of Jesus standing at God's right hand. (Acts of Apostles 7:55)
- So Cornelius gazed at the angel and was frightened, so he asked the angel; What is it Lord? And in reply the angel told him that his prayers and his gifts of mercy had ascended as a remembrance before the true God, Yehowah. God had heard his many prayers, and now had come to answer them.
- The man gazed at him and, becoming frightened, said; What is it, Lord? He said to him; Your prayers and gifts of mercy have ascended as a remembrance before God. (Acts of Apostles 10:4)
