~GEDERAH 1 (24) (Ge-de'rah) [Stone Pen]

- A city in the Shephelah assigned to Judah.
- This was the inheritance of the tribe of the sons of Judah by their families. (Joshua 15:20)
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And Shaaraim and Adithaim and Gederah and Gederothaim, fourteen cities and their settlements. (Joshua 15:36)
- Gederah is usually identified with Jedireh or Gedera, about 7 kilometers (4.5 miles) Northwest of the suggested site of Eshtaol. Some of the inhabitants of this city were known for their pottery.
- They were the potters and the inhabitants of Netaim and Gederah. It was with the king in his work that they dwelt there. (1 Chronicles 4:23)
