## ~GEDEROTHAIM (38) (Ged-e-ro-tha'im)[ Two Stone Pens]

- A name that means; Two Stone Pens. It appears among cities of Judah in the Shephelah, but its location is today unknown.
- This was the inheritance of the tribe of the sons of Judah by their families. (Joshua 15:20)
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And Shaaraim and Adithaim and Gederah and Gederothaim, fourteen cities and their settlements. (Joshua 15:36)
- Instead of Gederothaim, the Greek Septuagint reads and her sheepfolds, that is, the sheepfolds of the previously listed site, Gederah. This reading would drop the total number of cities in the list from 15 to the stated 14)
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And Zanoah and En-gannim, Tappuah and Enam. (Joshua 15:34)
- Jarmuth and Adullam, Socoh and Azekah. (Joshua 15:35)
- And Shaaraim and Adithaim and Gederah and Gederothaim, fourteen cities and their settlements. (Joshua 15:36)
- Since such an expression would be unusual in such lists, some suggest that the text could be rendered Gederah or Gederothaim rather than Gederah and Gederothaim.
