## ~GELILOTH (28)

(Gel-i'loth) [Regions, Circuits, from a root meaning roll, roll away]

- A site listed in connection with the boundary of Benjamin.
- And it was marked out northward and went out to En-shemesh and went out to Geliloth, which is in front of the ascent of Adummim, and it went down to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben. (Joshua 18:17)
- Geliloth's location, described as in front of the ascent of Adummim, matches that of Gilgal.
- And the boundary went up to Debir at the low plain of Achor and turning northward to Gilgal, which is in front of the ascent of Adummim, which is south of the torrent valley, and the boundary passed over to the waters of En-shemesh, and its termination proved to be En-rogel. (Joshua 15:7)
- For which reason some scholars consider it a variant name for the Gilgal near Jericho. Others suggest that Geliloth is a site or small region in the vicinity of Tal`at ed-Damm, Ma`ale Adummim in the Wadi el Oilt Southwest of Jericho.
