~GERSHOM 2 (48)

(Ger'shom) [An Alien Resident There]

- The firstborn son of Moses by Zipporah, born in Midian.
- After that Moses showed willingness to dwell with the man, and he gave Zipporah his daughter to Moses. (Exodus 2:21)
- Later she bore a son and he called his name Gershom, because, he said; An alien resident I have come to be in a foreign land. (Exodus 2:22)
- As for Moses the man of the true God, his sons themselves continued to be called among the tribe of the Levites. (1 Chronicles 23:14)
- The sons of Moses were Gershom and Eliezer. (1 Chronicles 23:15)
- The sons of Gershom were Shebuel the head. (1 Chronicles 23:16)
- Moses father-in-law Jethro came to Moses in the wilderness, bringing with him Moses wife Zipporah and their two sons, Gershom and Eliezer.
- So Jethro, Moses father-in-law, took Zipporah, Moses wife, after the sending of her away. (Exodus 18:2)
- And her two sons, the name of one of whom was Gershom, because, he said; An alien resident I have come to be in a foreign land. (Exodus 18:3)
- And the name of the other was Eliezer, because, to quote him, the God of my father is my helper in that he delivered me from Pharaoh's sword. (Exodus 18:4)
- The priestly service of **Gershom's** descendant Jonathan on behalf of the Danites was illegal, because, although he was a Levite, he was not of Aaron's family.
- After that the sons of Dan stood up the carved image for

themselves, and Jonathan the son of Gershom, Moses son, he and his sons became priests to the tribe of the Danites until the day of the lands being taken into exile. (Judges 18:30)
