~GILEAD 5 (20)

(Gil'e-ad) [probably derived from Galeed, meaning Witness Heap]

- A town mentioned by Hosea as being filled with untruth, bloodshed, and practicers of what is harmful.
- Gilead is a town of practicers of what is harmful, their footprints are blood. (Hosea 6:8)
- With Gilead what is uncanny, also untruth, have occurred. In Gilgal they have sacrificed even bulls. Moreover, their altars are like piles of stones in the furrows of the open field. (Hosea 12:11)
- Since Gilead is not identified as a city elsewhere in Scripture, some think that either Jabesh-gilead or Ramoth-gilead is meant.

 Others suggest that this refers to the entire region East of the Jordan.
