~GITTITH (17) (Git'tith)

- A musical expression of uncertain meaning, appearing in the superscriptions of (Psalms Chapters 8,81,84).
- The term seems to be derived from the Hebrew word *gath*, which is also the name of a town located on the border of Judah and Philistia.
- Some have suggested that Gittith denotes a tune associated with vintage songs, since gath refers to a winepress.
- The Greek Septuagint and the Latin Vulgate, therefore, render Gittith as winepresses.
