- The copper bowls of the temple were described as gleaming red, so pure, that they were as desirable as gold.
- And twenty small gold bowls worth a thousand darics and two utensils of good copper, gleaming red, as desirable as gold. (Ezra 8:27)
- The feet of the Cherubs in Ezekiel's vision were gleaming red as the glow of burnished copper.
- And their feet were straight feet, and the sole of their feet was like the sole of the foot of a calf, and they were gleaming as with the glow of burnished copper. (Ezekiel 1:7)
