- The king asked Nehemiah why his face was **gloomy** and he told him it was because of the **gloominess** of his heart.
- So the king said to me; Why is your face gloomy when you yourself are not sick? This is nothing but a **gloominess** of heart. At this I became very much afraid. (**Nehemiah 2:2**)
- Through Isaiah, Yehowah promised to bring a time of **gloomy** spiritual darkness up his people.
- And to the earth he will look, and, lo! Distress and darkness, obscurity, hard times and **gloominess** with no brightness. (**Isaiah 8:22**)
- Yehowah's day is spoken of as a day of **gloominess**, of fury and of distress.
- It is a day of darkness and **gloominess**, a day of clouds and thick gloom, like light of dawn spread out upon the mountains. There is a people numerous and mighty, one like it has not been made to exist from the indefinite past, and after it there will be none again to the years of generation after generation. (**Joel 2:2**)
- That day is a day of fury, a day of distress and of anguish, a day of storm and of desolation, a day of darkness and of **gloominess**, a day of clouds and of thick gloom. (**Zephaniah 1:15**)
