- Joseph asked the Pharaoh's servants why their faces were **gloomy** looking.
- And he began to inquire of the officers of Pharaoh who were with him in the jail of his masters house, saying; For what reason are your faces **gloomy** today? (**Genesis 40:7**)
- One of the ten plagues was a **gloomy** darkness over all the land of Egypt for three days.
- Moses immediately stretched his hand out toward the heavens, and a **gloomy** darkness began to occur in all the land of Egypt for three days. (**Exodus 10:22**)
- Nehemiah appeared **gloomy** before the king due to the conditions of his people Israel.

- Then I said to the king; Let the king himself live to time indefinite! Why should not my face become **gloomy** when the city, the house of the burial places of my forefathers, is devastated, and its very gates have been eaten up with fire? (**Nehemiah 2:3**)
