

~GOSHEN 2 (32)
(Go'shen)

- **A city in the mountainous region of Judah.**
- **This was the inheritance of the tribe of the sons of Judah by their families. (Joshua 15:20)**
- **And in the mountainous region Shamir and Jattir and Socoh. (Joshua 15:48)**
- **And Goshen and Holon and Giloh, eleven cities and their settlements. (Joshua 15:51)**
- **Some scholars tentatively identify it with Edh Dhahiriya, about 18 kilometers (11 miles) Southwest of Hebron. The land of Goshen referred to at;**
- **And Joshua went striking them from Kadesh-barnea to Gaza and all the land of Goshen and up to Gibeon. (Joshua 10:41)**
- **And Joshua proceeded to take all this land, the mountainous region and all the Negeb and all the land of Goshen and the Shephelah and the Arabah and the mountainous region of Israel and its Shephelah. (Joshua 11:16)**
- **Was apparently a district in its vicinity. This district would take in the mountainous region between Hebron and the Negeb.**
