

~GRATIFYING (28)

- The sacrifices of Israelites who had not stopped their wrong practices, but came to sacrifice anyway were not **gratifying** to Yehowah.
- What does this matter to me that you bring in even frankincense from Sheba and the good cane from the land far away? The whole burnt offerings of you people serve for no pleasure, and your very sacrifices have not been **gratifying** to me. (**Jeremiah 6:20**)
- They will not continue pouring out wine to Yehowah. And their sacrifices will not be **gratifying** to him, they are like the bread of times of mourning to them, all those eating it will defile themselves. For their bread is for their own soul, it will not come into the house of Yehowah. (**Hosea 9:4**)
- Yehowah promised that in time the gift offering of Judah and Jerusalem would become **gratifying** to Yehowah.
- And the gift offering of Judah and of Jerusalem will actually be **gratifying** to Yehowah, as in the days of long ago and as in the years of antiquity. (**Malachi 3:4**)
