[English, heartbroken, brokenhearted, desolate, despairing, wretched, miserable, Opposite of, overjoyed]

- Jeremiah described the condition of Jerusalem as grief-stricken after her fall to the Babylonians.
- The ways of Zion are mourning, because there are none coming to the festival. All her gates are laid desolate. Her priests are sighing. Her virgins are grief-stricken, and she herself has bitterness. (Lamentations 1:4)
- The ones grief-stricken in absence from your festal season I shall certainly gather together, absent from you they happened to be, because of bearing reproach on her account. (Zephaniah 3:18)
