- Jeremiah described the condition of Jerusalem as **grief-stricken** after her fall to the Babylonians.
- The ways of Zion are mourning, because there are none coming to the festival. All her gates are laid desolate. Her priests are sighing. Her virgins are **grief-stricken**, and she herself has bitterness. (**Lamentations 1:4**)
- The ones **grief-stricken** in absence from your festal season I shall certainly gather together, absent from you they happened to be, because of bearing reproach on her account. (**Zephaniah 3:18**)
