

## **~HABITATION (31)**

**[English, habitat, environment, surroundings, territory, locale]**

- The Psalmist speaks of Yehowah's reclaimed ones who wandered about in the wilderness and desert away from any place of **habitation**.
- They wandered about in the wilderness, in the desert, they did not find any way to a city of **habitation**. (**Psalms 107:4**)
- And to have them walk in the right way, so as to come to a city of **habitation**. (**Psalms 107:7**)
- And there he causes the hungry ones to dwell, so that they firmly establish a city of **habitation**. (**Psalms 107:36**)
- My own **habitation** has been pulled out and removed from me like the tent of shepherds. I have rolled up my life just like a loom worker; one proceeds to cut me off from the very threads of the warp. From daylight till night you keep handing me over. (**Isaiah 38:12**)
- David found favor with God and asked for the privilege of providing a place of **habitation** for God.
- He found favor in the sight of God and asked for the privilege of providing a **habitation** for the God of Jacob. (**Acts of Apostles 7:46**)
