- The Psalmist speaks of Yehowah's reclaimed ones who wandered about in the wilderness and desert away from any place of habitation.
- They wandered about in the wilderness, in the desert, they did not find any way to a city of habitation. (Psalms 107:4)
- And to have them walk in the right way, so as to come to a city of habitation. (Psalms 107:7)
- And there he causes the hungry ones to dwell, so that they firmly establish a city of habitation. (Psalms 107:36)
- My own habitation has been pulled out and removed from me like the tent of shepherds. I have rolled up my life just like a loom worker; one proceeds to cut me off from the very threads of the warp. From daylight till night you keep handing me over. (Isaiah 38:12)
- David found favor with God and asked for the privilege of providing a place of habitation for God.
- He found favor in the sight of God and asked for the privilege of providing a habitation for the God of Jacob. (Acts of Apostles 7:46)
