[English, behavior, practice, lifestyle, way of life, routine]

- Paul counsels, bad associations spoil useful **habits**.
- Do not be misled! Bad associations spoil useful **habits**. (**1 Corinthians 15:33**)
- An overseer should be of **moderate** habits.
- The overseer should therefore be irreprehensible, a husband of one wife, moderate in **habits**, sound in mind, orderly, hospitable, qualified to teach. (**1 Timothy 3:2**)
- Women should be likewise.
- Women should likewise be serious, not slanderous, moderate in **habits**, faithful in all things. (**1 Timothy 3:11**)
- Also aged men
- Let the aged men be moderate in **habits**, serious, sound in mind, healthy in faith, in love, in endurance. (**Titus 2:2**)
- Peter warned of those who through loose **habits** entice others to erroneous conduct.
- For they utter swelling expressions of no profit, and by the desires of the flesh and by loose **habits** they entice those who are just escaping from people who conduct themselves in error. (**2 Peter 2:18**)
