

~HACHILAH (28)
(Hach-i'lah)

- **A hill in the Wilderness of Ziph, where David and his men concealed themselves from King Saul.**
- **Later the men of Ziph went up to Saul at Gibeah, saying; Is not David concealing himself close by us in the places difficult to approach at Horesh, on the hill of **Hachilah**, which is to the right side of Jeshimon? (1 Samuel 23:19)**
- **In time the men of Ziph came to Saul at Gibeah, saying; Is not David concealing himself on the hill of **Hachilah**, facing Jeshimon? (1 Samuel 26:1)**
- **And Saul proceeded to rise up and go down to the wilderness of Ziph, and with him three thousand men, the chosen ones of Israel, to look for David in the wilderness of Ziph. (1 Samuel 26:2)**
- **And Saul took up camping on the hill of **Hachilah**, which faces Jeshimon, by the road, while David was dwelling in the wilderness. And he got to see that Saul had come after him into the wilderness. (1 Samuel 26:3)**
- **Today its exact location is unknown.**
