- Ancestor of Zabdiel and his son Jashobeam. Jashobeam was the head one of David's top three mighty men and is called, the son of a Hachmonite.
- And this is the list of the mighty men that belonged to David; Jashobeam the son of a Hachmonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over three hundred slain at one time. (1 Chronicles 11:11)
- Over the first division of the first month there was Jashobeam the son of Zabdiel, and in his division there were twenty-four thousand. (1 Chronicles 27:2)
- Hachmonite is spelled Tahchemonite at;
- These are the names of the mighty men that belonged to David, Josheb-basshebeth a Tahchemonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over eight hundred slain at one time. (2 Samuel 23:8)
- Elkanah and Isshiah and Azarel and Joezer and Jashobeam, the Korahites. (1 Chronicles 12:6)
- Refers to the same Jashobeam, the Hachmonites were descendants of the Levite Korah.
