

~HADAD 2 (27)
(Ha'dad)

- Successor to the kingship of Edom after the death of Husham. **Hadad** son of Bedad, who defeated the Midianites in the field of Moab, apparently ruled from the city of Avith.
- Now these are the kings who reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the sons of Israel. (**Genesis 36:31**)
- When Husham died, **Hadad** son of Bedad, who defeated the Midianites in the field of Moab, began to reign instead of him, and the name of his city was Avith. (**Genesis 36:35**)
- When **Hadad** died, Samlah from Masrekah began to reign instead of him. (**Genesis 36:36**)
- Eventually Husham died, and **Hadad** the son of Bedad, who defeated Midian in the field of Moab, began to reign in place of him. And the name of his city was Avith. (**1 Chronicles 1:46**)
- Eventually **Hadad** died, and Samlah from Masrekah began to reign in place of him. (**1 Chronicles 1:47**)
