## ~HADAD 2 (27) (Ha'dad)

- Successor to the kingship of Edom after the death of Husham.
  Hadad son of Bedad, who defeated the Midianites in the field of Moab, apparently ruled from the city of Avith.
- Now these are the kings who reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the sons of Israel. (Genesis 36:31)
- When Husham died, Hadad son of Bedad, who defeated the Midianites in the field of Moab, began to reign instead of him, and the name of his city was Avith. (Genesis 36:35)
- When Hadad died, Samlah from Masrekah began to reign instead of him. (Genesis 36:36)
- Eventually Husham died, and Hadad the son of Bedad, who defeated Midian in the field of Moab, began to reign in place of him. And the name of his city was Avith. (1 Chronicles 1:46)
- Eventually Hadad died, and Samlah from Masrekah began to reign in place of him. (1 Chronicles 1:47)
