~HADAD 3 (31) (Ha'dad)

- Another king of Edom, husband of Mehetabel. Hadad succeeded Baal-hanan to the kingship, and the name of his city was Pau.
- And these are the kings that reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the sons of Israel. Bela the son of Beor, the name of whose city was Dinhabah. (1 Chronicles 1:43)
- Eventually Baal-hanan died, and Hadad began to reign in place of him, and the name of his city was Pau, and the name of his wife was Mehetabel, the daughter of Matred, the daughter of Mezahab. (1 Chronicles 1:50)
- Eventually Hadad died. And the sheiks of Edom came to be sheik Timna, sheik Alvah, sheik Jetheth. (1 Chronicles 1:51)
- He is called Hadar at,
- When Baalhanan son of Achbor died, Hadar began to reign instead of him, and the name of his city was Pau, and the name of his wife was Mehetabel the daughter of Matred the daughter of Mezahab. (Genesis 36:39)
- Which may be due to a scribal error, since the Hebrew letters corresponding to $\bf r$ and $\bf d$ are very similar.
