## ~HAGAB (28) (Ha'gab) [Grasshopper]

- Ancestor of a family of Nethinim temple slaves. The sons of Hagab are mentioned among those returning with Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E. from exile in Babylon.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The Nethinim, the sons of Ziha, the sons of Hasupha, the sons of Tabbaoth. (Ezra 2:43)
- The sons of Hagab, the sons of Salmai, the sons of Hanan. (Ezra 2:46)
- The name Hagab, however, does not appear in the parallel list at;
- A devout man and one fearing God together with all his household, and he made many gifts of mercy to the people and made supplication to God continually. (Acts of Apostles 10:2)
