## ~HAMMON 1 (27)

(Ham'mon) [meaning Place of a Hot, Spring]

- A city on the boundary of Asher.
- Then the fifth lot came out for the tribe of the sons of Asher by their families. (Joshua 19:24)
- And their boundary came to be Helkath and Hali and Beten and Achshaph. (Joshua 19:25)
- And Allammelech and Amad and Mishal. And it reached westward to Carmel and to Shihor-libnath. (Joshua 19:26)
- And it went back toward the rising of the sun to Beth-dagon and reached to Zebulun and the valley of Iphtah-el to the north, to Beth-emek and Neiel, and it went out to Cabul on the left.

  (Joshua 19:27)
- And to Ebron and Rehob and Hammon and Kanah as far as populous Sidon. (Joshua 19:28)
- It is generally identified with Umm el `Awamid, on the Mediterranean seacoast, about 16 kilometers (10 miles) South-Southwest of Tyre.
