~HAMON-GOG (24) (Ha'mon-Gog) [Gog's Crowd]

- The English derivation of the Hebrew name of a valley, evidently symbolic, described as the valley of those passing through on the East of the Dead sea. In this valley, Gog and all his forces are buried after their destruction by Yehowah.
- And it must occur in that day that I shall give to Gog a place there, a burial place in Israel, the valley of those passing through on the east of the sea, and it will be stopping up those passing through. And there they will have to bury Gog and all his crowd, and they will be certain to call it the Valley of Gog's Crowd. (Ezekiel 39:11)
- And those passing through must pass along through the land, and should one actually see the bone of a man he must also build beside it a marker, until those who do the burying will have buried it in the Valley of Gog's Crowd. (Ezekiel 39:15) Footnotes
