

**~HANANIAH 7 (18)**

**(Han-a-ni'ah) [meaning Yehowah Has Shown Favor, Yehowah Has Been Gracious]**

- The **Hebrew** name of Shadrach, one of Daniel's three Jewish companions taken to Babylon in **617 B.C.E.**
- Now there happened to be among them some of the sons of Judah, Daniel, **Hananiah**, Mishaël and Azariah. (**Daniel 1:6**)
- And to them the principal court official went assigning names. So he assigned to Daniel the name of Belteshazzar, and to **Hananiah**, Shadrach, and to Mishaël, Meshach, and to Azariah, Abednego. (**Daniel 1:7**)
