

~HANDBREADTH (56)

- A linear measure approximately corresponding to the width of the hand at the base of the fingers. The handbreadth is reckoned at 7.4 centimeters (2.9 inches), four fingerbreadths equaled a handbreadth, and six handbreadths equaled a cubit.
- And you must make for it a rim of a **handbreadth** round about, and you must make the border of gold for its rim round about. (**Exodus 25:25**)
- Next he made for it a rim of a **handbreadth** round about and made a border of gold for its rim round about. (**Exodus 37:12**)
- And its thickness was a **handbreadth**, and its brim was like the workmanship of the brim of a cup, a lily blossom. Two thousand bath measures were what it would contain. (**1 Kings 7:26**)
- And its thickness was a **handbreadth**, and its brim was like the workmanship of the brim of a cup, a lily blossom. As a receptacle, three thousand bath measures were what it could contain. (**2 Chronicles 4:5**)
- And, look! There was a wall outside the house all round about. And in the **hand** of the man there was the measuring reed of six cubits, by a cubit and a **handbreadth**. And he began to measure the breadth of the thing built, one reed, and the height, one reed. (**Ezekiel 40:5**)
- And the ledges for setting down things were of one **handbreadth**, firmly fixed on the interior, all around, and upon the tables they would deposit the flesh of the gift offering. (**Ezekiel 40:43**)
- And these are the measurements of the altar in cubits, a cubit being a cubit and a **handbreadth**. And its bottom is a cubit. And a cubit is the width. And its border is upon its lip round about, one span. And this is the base of the altar. (**Ezekiel 43:13**)
