

**~HANNATHON (20)**

**(Han'na-thon) [possibly from a root meaning show favor, be gracious]**

- **A boundary city of Zebulun.**
- **Next the third lot came up for the sons of Zebulun by their families, and the boundary of their inheritance came to be as far as Sarid. (Joshua 19:10)**
- **And the boundary went around it on the north to Hannathon, and its terminations proved to be at the valley of Iphtah-el. (Joshua 19:14)**
- **Most scholars tentatively identify Hannathon with Tell el-Bedeiwiye, Tel Hannaton, about 10 kilometers (6 miles) North-Northwest of Nazareth. Hannathon appears in the records of Assyrian King Tiglath-pileser III and also in the Amarna Tablets**
