## ~HAPHARAIM (19) (Haph'a-ra'im) [Place of Digging]

- A site on the territorial boundary of the tribe of Issachar.
- It was for Issachar that the fourth lot came out, for the sons of Issachar by their families. (Joshua 19:17)
- And their boundary came to be to Jezreel and Chesulloth and Shunem. (Joshua 19:18)
- And Hapharaim and Shion and Anaharath. (Joshua 19:19)
- It cannot be identified with certainty. However, most scholars tentatively locate it at et-Taiyiba, about 12 kilometers (7.5 miles) Northwest of Beth-shean. Hapharaim also appears in a list of the Palestinian cities conquered by Egypt's King Shishak.
