

**~HARARITE (32)**  
**(Har'a-rite)**

- The designation of certain mighty men of David.
- These are the names of the mighty men that belonged to David. Josheb-basshebeth a Tahchemonite, the head of the three. He was brandishing his spear over eight hundred slain at one time. (2 Samuel 23:8)
- And next to him was Shammah the son of Agee the Hararite. And the Philistines proceeded to gather themselves to Lehi, where there then happened to be a tract of the field full of lentils, and the people themselves fled because of the Philistines. (2 Samuel 23:11)
- Shammah the Hararite, Ahiam the son of Sharar the Hararite. (2 Samuel 23:33)
- As for the mighty men of the military forces, there were Asahel the brother of Joab, Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem. (1 Chronicles 11:26)
- The sons of Hashem the Gizonite, Jonathan the son of Shagee the Hararite. (1 Chronicles 11:34)
- Ahiam the son of Sacar the Hararite, Eliphaz the son of Ur. (1 Chronicles 11:35)
- They were perhaps from the hill country of Judah.
