## ~HARIM 2 (61) (Ha'rim) [Devoted, Banned]

- The founder of a non-priestly family, 320 of whom returned from Babylon to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The sons of Harim, three hundred and twenty. (Ezra 2:32)
- The sons of Harim, three hundred and twenty. (Nehemiah 7:35)
- As with members of the priestly family of the same name HARIM 1, eight descendants of this Harim also took foreign wives and dismissed them.
- And of Israel, of the sons of Parosh there were Ramiah and Izziah and Malchijah and Mijamin and Eleazar and Malchijah and Benaiah. (Ezra 10:25)
- And of the sons of Harim, Eliezer, Isshijah, Malchijah, Shemaiah, Shimeon. (Ezra 10:31)
- Benjamin, Malluch and Shemariah. (Ezra 10:32)
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
- Likewise their representative attested the trustworthy arrangement contracted during Nehemiah's governorship.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)

- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- The heads of the people, Parosh, Pahath-moab, Elam, Zattu, Bani. (Nehemiah 10:14)
- Malluch, Harim, Baanah. (Nehemiah 10:27)
- One son of Harim, Malchijah, helped repair Jerusalem's wall.
- Another measured section was what Malchijah the son of Harim and Hasshub the son of Pahath-moab repaired, and also the Tower of the Bake Ovens. (Nehemiah 3:11)
