[English, damaging, injurious, destructive, detrimental, dangerous, hurtful, unsafe, risky, wounding, Opposite of, harmless]

- Woe to the ones enacting **harmful** regulations, laws not based on principle.
- Woe to those who are enacting harmful regulations and those who, constantly writing, have written out sheer trouble. (Isaiah 10:1)
- Woe to those who are scheming what is harmful, and to those practicing what is bad, upon their beds! By the light of the morning they proceed to do it, because it is in the power of their hand. (Micah 2:1)
- Isaiah counsels that the harmful man should leave his harmful way, for Yehowah to have mercy upon him.
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to Yehowah, who will have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he will forgive in a large way. (Isaiah 55:7)
- The residents of Gilead were bloodguilty men and their way was a harmful one.
- Gilead is a town of practicers of what is harmful, their footprints are blood. (Hosea 6:8)
- Paul prayed that Christians may be delivered from harmful and wicked men, realizing that the Christian faith is not the possession of all people.
- And that we may be delivered from harmful and wicked men, for faith is not a possession of all people. (2 Thessalonians 3:2)
