[English, damaging, injurious, destructive, detrimental, dangerous, hurtful, unsafe, risky, wounding, Opposite of, **harmless**]

- Woe to the ones enacting **harmful** regulations, laws not based on principle.
- Woe to those who are enacting **harmful** regulations and those who, constantly writing, have written out sheer trouble. (**Isaiah 10:1**)
- Woe to those who are scheming what is **harmful**, and to those practicing what is bad, upon their beds! By the light of the morning they proceed to do it, because it is in the power of their hand. (**Micah 2:1**)
- Isaiah counsels that the **harmful** man should leave his **harmful** way, for Yehowah to have mercy upon him.
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the **harmful** man his thoughts, and let him return to Yehowah, who will have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he will forgive in a large way. (**Isaiah 55:7**)
- The residents of Gilead were bloodguilty men and their way was a **harmful** one.
- Gilead is a town of practicers of what is **harmful**, their footprints are blood. (**Hosea 6:8**)
- Paul prayed that Christians may be delivered from **harmful** and wicked men, realizing that the Christian faith is not the possession of all people.
- And that we may be delivered from **harmful** and wicked men, for faith is not a possession of all people. (**2 Thessalonians 3:2**)
