[English, musically, tunefully, melodiously, sweetly, pleasantly, Opposite of, discordantly]

- In union with Jesus Christ the whole building of spiritual stones must be harmoniously joined together through the Holy Spirit.
- In union with him the whole building, being harmoniously joined together, is growing into a holy temple for Yehowah. (Ephesians 2:21)
- Paul then expands upon this showing that the Christian congregation is also a body working harmoniously together at every joint to provide what is needed.
- From him all the body, by being harmoniously joined together and being made to cooperate through every joint that gives what is needed, according to the functioning of each respective member in due measure, makes for the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love. (Ephesians 4:16)
- Whereas he is not holding fast to the head, to the one from whom all the body, being supplied and harmoniously joined together by means of its joints and ligaments, goes on growing with the growth that God gives. (Colossians 2:19)
- Paul writes to the Colossian Christians that love is the spiritual bond that will help them all to act harmoniously together.
- That their hearts may be comforted, that they may be harmoniously joined together in love and with a view to all the riches of the full assurance of their understanding, with a view to an accurate knowledge of the sacred secret of God, namely, Christ. (Colossians 2:2)
